



Dear Leukemia & Lymphoma Society Contributor,

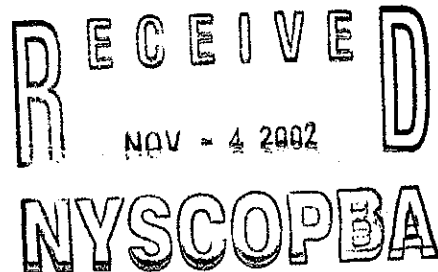
